
Jallianwala Bagh, a public garden in Amritsar houses a memorial of National importance; established in 1951 by the Government of India to commemorate the massacre of peaceful demonstration of unarmed people including women and children, by the British forces on the occasion of the Punjabi New Year, that is, April 13, 1919. The visit to the place enlightened the students about the historical aspect related to the Jallianwala Bagh and were moved by the history of the bone-chilling massacre.

The Beating Retreat Ceremony at the Wagah Border, the ceremony of the flag lowering in the evening conducted by Indian Border Security Forces (BSF) and Pakistan Rangers (PR) at the border was indeed mesmerizing.

The Durgiana Temple which is situated at the site of a small lake known as Durgiana.

The tour was accompanied by the Assistant Professors Dr. Reena and Mr. Arun Kumar. All the students enjoyed the tour very much.
